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### **Proof of Vaccination Update**

According to Region of Peel's Medical Officer of Health, effective November 1, 2021, all participants 12 years and older entering sports or recreational fitness facilities in Peel will be required to provide proof of vaccination or a valid medical exemption, along with identification. This will apply to all participants and spectators in local recreation centres, including youth, coaches, instructors, caregivers, volunteers and game officials.

Indoor sports venues in Peel Region have been identified as locations of concern which have been driving transmission of COVID-19 over the last few weeks. This current update is consistent with other municipalities and will help to protect Peel's active youth sports community.

### **Enhanced Vaccine Certificates with QR codes**

In advance of October 22, which is when businesses can start to scan your QR code for proof of vaccination, you can download an enhanced vaccine certificate with a QR code.

Download your enhanced vaccine certificate from the [provincial vaccine portal](#). You can also call the Provincial Vaccine Contact Centre at [1-833-943-3900](#) to have your enhanced vaccine certificate emailed or mailed to you. The Town of Caledon will accept both electronic and paper versions.

You will need to continue to show identification with your name and date of birth along with your proof of vaccination when visiting your local recreation centre.
